Born and raised in Brooklyn, NY, Catherine's artwork began to receive a good deal of public attention throughout her school years. She won notable recognition from the City of New York, including various awards from the city's cultural arts coordinator, school board president, chancellor, and superintendent. During junior high school, her painting of *Times Square* was selected to exhibit in the second largest art museum in New York City, the *Brooklyn Museum of Art*.

Catherine's appreciation of fine art emerged and her formal training developed further as she was accepted into a prominent art school in Manhattan. During this time, her paintings appeared in many exhibitions throughout the city to outstanding reviews.

She enjoyed an extensive career - all in the heart of NYC - in publishing, graphic design, advertising, illustration, and writing.

In 2004, her first book, "*Super Silly Sayings That Are Over Your Head*" was published (Starfish Press), and received a *Benjamin Franklin Literary Award* nomination for Best New Voice. Her next book, "*What's That Look On Your Face?*" (AAPC) 2008, received numerous accolades from critics, educators, parents, and - most importantly - children. Her visually expressive books have had quite an impact on the educational market, having been used in educational curriculums and teacher manuals.

These days, she is occupied with numerous art projects, and is also working on a new children's book. Catherine currently lives in California with her family.
